The Hall of Fame Nomination: The Hall of Fame Selection Chairman has been receiving nominations for the 2021 Induction. We are proud to say we have received 13 new nominations. That makes 37 nominees for the selection ballot. We would like to take this opportunity to share with you what happens now since the nomination deadline has passed.

Selection Committee: Chairperson: Chairperson will be selected by the President of the Hall of Fame. The Chairperson will cast his/her ballot at the same time as committee members and the ballot will be placed in an envelope and given to the President of the Hall of Fame. The ballot is only opened in case of a tie. **Selection Committee Will consist of:** Central Auto Racing Boosters Hall of Fame and Museum Board members (Officers and Directors) plus all living Inductees. The 5-9 volunteers that volunteer during the October meeting will not be possible this year due to the pandemic and the safety of everyone.

Voting Process

On the 1st of November a short biography of each Nominee along with a Self-Address Stamped Envelope will be given or mailed to each person on the Selection Committee. All ballots must be returned, and post marked no later than November 30th to be counted. All ballots will remain sealed until the meeting can be set for the ballots to be counted by the Officers/Board. Due to the pandemic it will not be a public meeting. The CARB President will also be attending that meeting for opening of the ballots. The 8 inductees will be announced on Racinboys Live on Saturday, December 12, 2020 due to the pandemic. The ballots along with the envelopes that they were sent in will be given to the Chairperson, shown to the Committee Members, and then destroyed. 


